Complaints

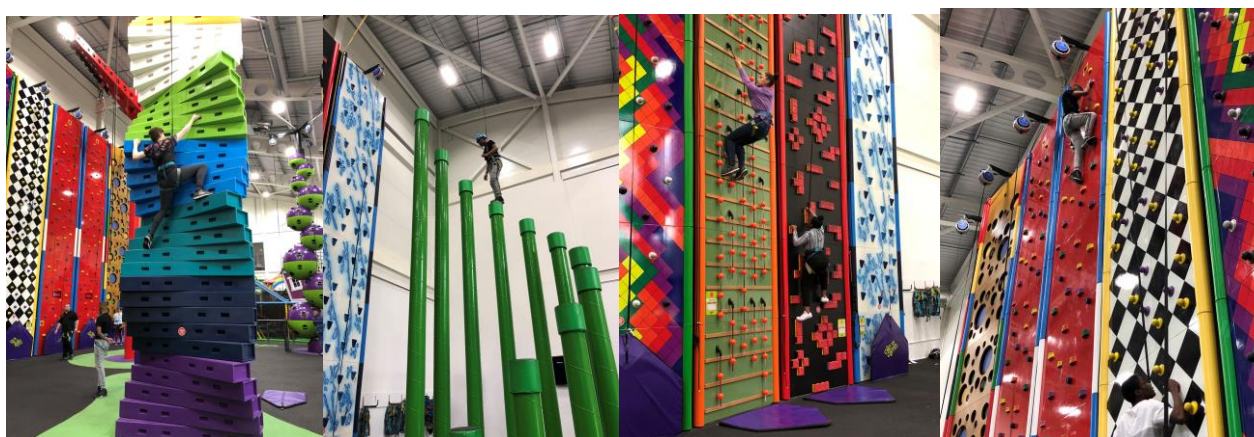
If for any reason you wish to make a complaint, kindly complete and return to us the Parents Complaints Form on the website and we will respond as quickly as possible.
