Dear Parents and Guardians

Happy New Year to you! Following the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday of the new lockdown, I want to reassure you that The Tutorial Foundation is open for all our students. Where students choose to, or need to self-isolate, we will to provide remote learning or workpacks to minimise the impact on our students' education.

We are already Lateral Flow Testing all students and staff on a regular basis to ensure we remain safe and Covid-free for everyone onsite. If anyone has been in close contact with a positive case, we will test those students and staff daily for 7 days. Anyone who tests positive will self-isolate for 10 days.

Please let the office know if your child or anyone in the household tests positive or displays any Covid symptoms as you should all self-isolate for 10 days at home.
